

Purpose:

The recipient of this award must be a graduating senior high school student who is a resident of Algonquin and has been accepted to an accredited vocational school, Community College (two-year school), or a College or University (four-year school). Recipients of the award will be selected without regard to sex, race or religion.

Selection Criteria (please review the criteria carefully):

- **1.** The Algonquin Lions Foundation will place a stronger consideration* on students applying for the award who have a
 - Vision or Hearing disability, or both
 - Diabetes
 - And/Or, other types of physical disabilities/

*This does Not Guarantee an applicant with these disabilities will be selected for the award!

- **2.** Any graduating high school senior student living in Algonquin who is attending high school and is a student in good standing.
- **3.** Provide one written reference from a teacher.
- **4.** Complete the application for the Ted Spella Educational Award including a five-paragraph essay entitled "What my three major accomplishments will be in the next ten years". The essay should be typed and double spaced.
- **5.** Applicants must have a minimum of a 2.5 Cumulative Academic Grade Point Average at the time of this application filing. (Based on a 4-point scale)
- **6.** A recent high school transcript must be included with the following application.

Requirements:

1. All applications must be postmarked by <u>March 13, 2020</u> and mailed to the following address:

- A \$1,250 award will be presented to the recipient at the beginning of each semester (2020 Fall and 2021 Spring Semesters) provided the student remains in good standing and remains in school.
- 3. The award recipient and their parent(s) or guardian(s) must attend a regular meeting of the Algonquin Lions Club to introduce herself or himself. The recipient and their parents/guardians will have dinner with Lions Club members as a courtesy of the Algonquin Lions Foundation. The Lions Club will be taking several group photographs of the recipient(s), their parents, and Club Officers. It is recommended,



that the recipient furnish a photograph to the Algonquin Lions Foundation for purposes of publicity. (A high school graduation portrait.)

Selection Procedure:

- 1. Gender, race, or religion will not be considered in the selection procedure.
- 2. To evaluate the applications fairly, all applications will receive an "application code" upon receipt. This cover sheet of this application containing personal information of the applicant will be removed and the selection committee will only see the activity sheets and essays.
- 3. The final selection will be made by the Algonquin Lions Foundation Educational Award committee.
- 4. All decisions are final. If the person awarded the scholarship does not attend school in the fall semester they are required to pay back the award in full.
